



Sabre Sprint

Sabre was originally contacted by the Ministry of Defence to help develop a piece of emergency escape breathing apparatus that would safeguard against unnecessary loss of life, like that seen during the Falklands war. During this conflict it was found that 90% of fatalities on HMS Sheffield died through smoke inhalation. The result of research conducted by Sabre led to the development of the Emergency Life Support Apparatus or 'ELSA'.

The **ELSA Sprint** is a positive pressure escape set providing air on demand for situations where the escape route may require a lot of physical exertion or where the maximum levels of protection are required.

The ELSA Sprint offers:-

- Choice of 2 durations - 10 or 15 minutes
- Automatic activation
- High visibility carry bag
- Clear visible contents gauge
- Warning whistle to notify of low air content
- Positive pressure facemask
- First breath activation
- Tempest demand valve offers excellent flow performance
