



City & Guilds Level 3 Qualification in Emergency Rescue & Recovery of Casualties from Confined Spaces: Water (6150-05)

Duration 2/3 Days (dependant on experience)

Introduction

Suitable for persons who have been selected and trained to work in high risk confined spaces, and who may form part of a team of rescue workers who may need to enter and assist persons to exit the confined space in the event of an emergency. Learners will have prior to the commencement of course already completed the City & Guilds 6150-03 qualification in Working in High Risk Confined Spaces

Course Content

- Prepare to work safely in confined spaces under emergency conditions
- Enter and exit confined spaces safely
- Prepare and use breathing apparatus in accordance with manufacturers' specifications
- Use rescue equipment safely and in accordance with manufacturers' instructions
- Follow procedures and work safely
- Deal with emergencies
- Use appropriate behaviour for carrying out emergency rescue and recovery of casualties from confined spaces
- Use appropriate water industry knowledge for carrying out emergency rescue and recovery of casualties from confined spaces
- Apply relevant water industry standards for carrying out emergency rescue and recovery of casualties from confined spaces

Training Information

The course comprises one/two days training and one day of assessment. Candidates should bring their own safety footwear, waterproof clothing, hard hat and working gloves for the practical exercises.

Course content will include written tasks, hands-on demonstrations and practical exercises, supplemented with classroom based tutorials and pre and post course assessments.

This unit will be assessed by direct observation of a rescue in a confined space and a written paper.

Additional Information

Delegates attending this course should be physically and mentally fit to withstand the rigours of training. Consideration must be given to the selection of staff undertaking rescue team duties.

Training Certification

City & Guilds question papers and practical assessment observation checklists will be submitted upon assessment completion and certificates will be issued subject to final verification.
